

**WELCOME TO CTN 161: WEB PRODUCTION 2**

This web development class focuses on intermediate web design and production. Students will be required to integrate graphics and complex code to produce professional quality web sites. Students will be introduced to design and production techniques as well as web development tools and image editors. Prerequisite: CTN 160 or permission. 5 credit

**COURSE MATERIAL**

The book for the course is HTML, XHTML, and CSS, Sixth Edition (Visual Quickstart Guide) by Elizabeth Castro (ISBN-10: 0-321-43084-0). This book is available at the campus bookstore, online booksellers and at many local bookstores. In addition to the book, you may be assigned additional reading or study material. Such material will either be online, or you will need to access it via your local library.



Finally, it is recommended that you have a USB Flash Drive specifically designated for this class. A 1 GB drive will be sufficient and can generally be purchased for around \$10.
